Protocole SANITAIRE COVID-19

Lux Masters Open 2020 / Championnats Nationaux Masters du Luxembourg 10 et 11 Octobre 2020

Health recommendations related to the fight against the COVID-19 pandemic will be in effect on the date of the event

Access to the swimming pool:

- Only competitive swimmers, coaches, officials and the Swimming Luxembourg organizing team will have access to the pool.
- Access to the swimming pool is prohibited for visitors and spectators.
- Access to the stands is prohibited.
- Families will be able to watch the competitor's races in the cafeteria area or in the main entrance hall.

Wearing a mask :

- Wearing a mask is compulsory in the building except in the pool and showers
- Before the warm-up and races, competitors will be asked to come behind the starting block in swimsuits, goggles and mask only (no swimmer chair or clothing bin).
- Each competitors are requested to bring a small bag / sachet to put the mask in at the edge of the pool (before the starting block. During warm-up and before races)

Disinfectants :

- Products for hand disinfection are available at the entrance to the changing rooms.
- All concerned are requested to disinfect their hands before entering the changing rooms.
- The changing rooms and toilets will be disinfected regularly.

Swimming lanes :

The number maximum of swimmers per lane is : 8 per lane (same for 25m or 50m pool)

Officials:

- Officials will have their own changing rooms.
- Officials will be separated from the athletes.
- A starter zone will be set up.

Others:

- Wearing swim slides / sandals / Crocs is mandatory (No sneakers, shoes, ...)
- Hairdryers are out of order.
- Swimmers cannot bring their own hairdryer.

Cafétéria :

- The number of seats in the cafeteria is 150 at most.
- Each table can only accommodate a maximum of 10 people, even people being in the same family. The fine set by the government is 139 euros per person and 4000 euros for the organizer.
- Customers are only served in seats
- The tables will be disinfected at each change of customer
- Tables placed side by side are separated by a distance of at least 1.5 meters or, in the event of a shorter distance, by a barrier or a physical separation to limit the risk of infection
- Wearing a mask is mandatory for customers when they are not seated at the table
- Wearing a mask is mandatory for staff in direct contact with the customer

Failure to follow the protocol will result in exclusion from the competition.
