- Participate in FLNS activities requiring his presence and/or expertise.
- Attend internal Swimming Luxembourg training courses and training courses offered by the FLNS.
- Actively participate in the club's sporting and non-sporting events.

- In-depth knowledge of the various techniques for developing swimmers' skills outside the water (strength training, mobility, etc.)
